TRAVEL ARRANGEMENTS			
The collection point is Ryalls Court, N20 0RZ where children will meet and travel together to the airport. We will fly directly to Spain and take a private coach on arrival to our Camp. At the end of the trip, we will follow the same arrangements and children will be collected at our meeting point in Ryalls Court again.			

AIM OF OUR SUMMER CAMP

This camp is crafted to elevate proficiency in all aspects of the Spanish language —speaking, listening, reading, and writing—with a special focus on fostering creativity. The learning experience will be immersed in continuous exposure to Spanish, and our Olé staff will reinforce these lessons through dedicated sessions to ensure objectives are achieved. Unlike typical school trips, Olé teachers actively engage in all activities, share meals with students, and offer children 24 hour support and access to an Ole tutor or member of the team for those feeling unwell, homesick, or worried. Simultaneously, we remain accessible for parents needing to contact us, with advance notice provided for temporary unavailability during activities like water sessions

STUDENT BEHAVIOUR

We anticipate students to conduct themselves appropriately throughout the trip, displaying politeness towards staff and members of the public at all times. While students are allowed to bring mobiles or cameras, these items will be securely stored during activities and only returned to students during our designated recreation time, from 8 pm to 9 pm, for the purpose of texting parents or friends. Prior to the trip, there will be a meeting where students will receive a T-shirt. It is expected that they wear this T-shirt during travel to Spain and back. Once at the camp, wearing the T-shirt is optional.

THE FOOD

Maintaining a balanced diet is essential, especially during engaging activities. Spanish cuisine, renowned for its freshness, plays a pivotal role in this regard. The camp is equipped with its own kitchen and a dedicated cook who will prepare daily meals for the students. If there are any dietary concerns, such as allergies or religious observances, kindly ensure they are documented in the form. All meals are covered and included in this trip.

THE ACTIVITIES

The primary objective is to acquire Spanish language skills while actively engaging in nature, adhering to specific instructions. Secondary students will work on new GCSE/A Levels topics with Ole teachers. As for primary school students, lessons will focus on reinforcing language through interactions with camp monitors, along with incorporating language into meals and games
